CATECHIST'S SOCIAL ~ On Wednesday 18th September 6.30pm, Mrs Natalie Orefice, the Diocesan Director of Evangelisation & Catechesis, will be visiting the Parish to meet all involved in catechesis (catechists, children's liturgy, Readers & Ministers, etc.) & to share resources. MARY'S MEALS ~ Earlier this year, I received a very generous donation of several thousand pounds from a parishioner towards charitable work. At the same time, I received a request from Mary's Meals, a Charity, which provides meals for hungry children, to sponsor a school. This sponsorship would provide a daily meal for all the children being educated, for a whole year! In the name of the Parish, I started sponsoring Ndundundu School in Zambia, which has 267 pupils.
