that Jesus Christ is Lord!*

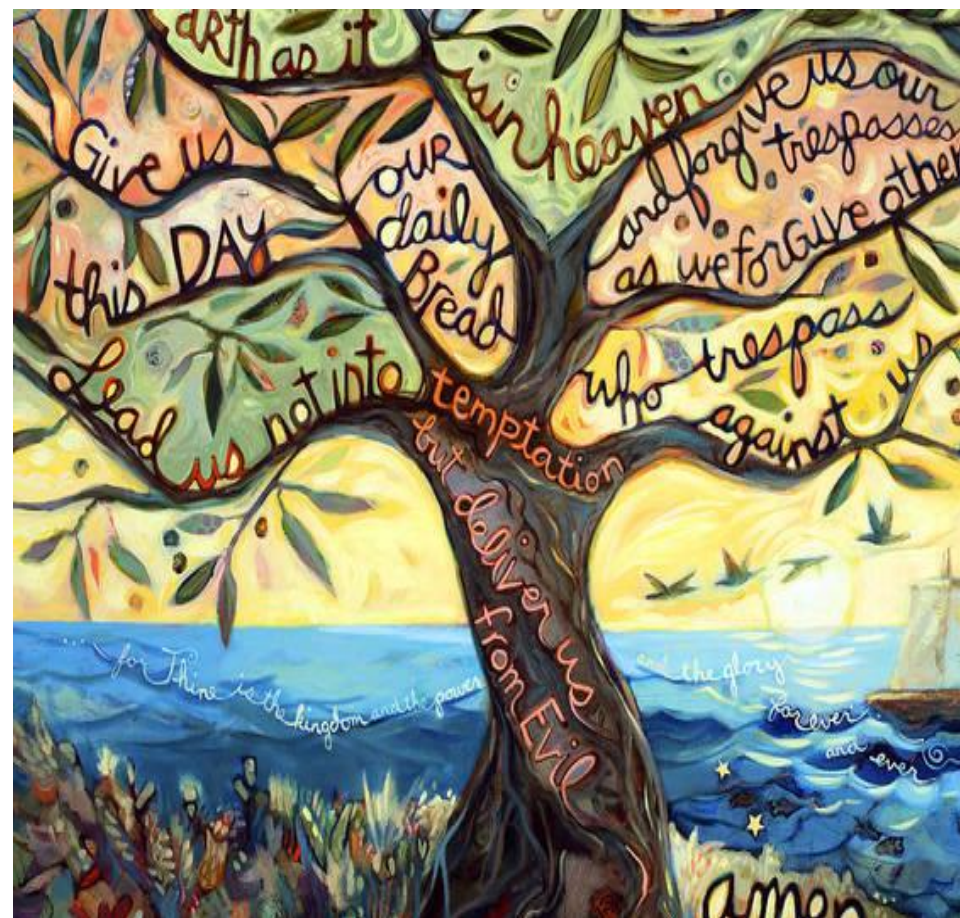
