A MESSAGE FROM OUR BISHOP: "THE ASSISTED DYING BILL tabled by Kim Leadbeater MP to remove legal safeguards to allow medically assisted suicide has been introduced into Parliament and is expected to be debated and voted upon on the 29th Nov. Please continue to contact your MP to make your opposition known. I have been grateful to all who have shared with me MP responses from around the Diocese... On Wed. 13th Nov., the Bishops of England and Wales will be coming together for a Eucharistic Holy Hour to pray and intercede that the dignity of the human person and the culture of life be upheld in the face of the assisted suicide legislation being brought before Parliament. Cardinal Nichols invites every parish to be united with the bishops in this powerful prayer of intercession." Holy Hours will be arranged in this Parish on the 13th Nov., and also, on Tuesday 19th Nov., 7.00pm, there will be a guest Speaker visiting the Parish from the East Cheshire Hospice.
