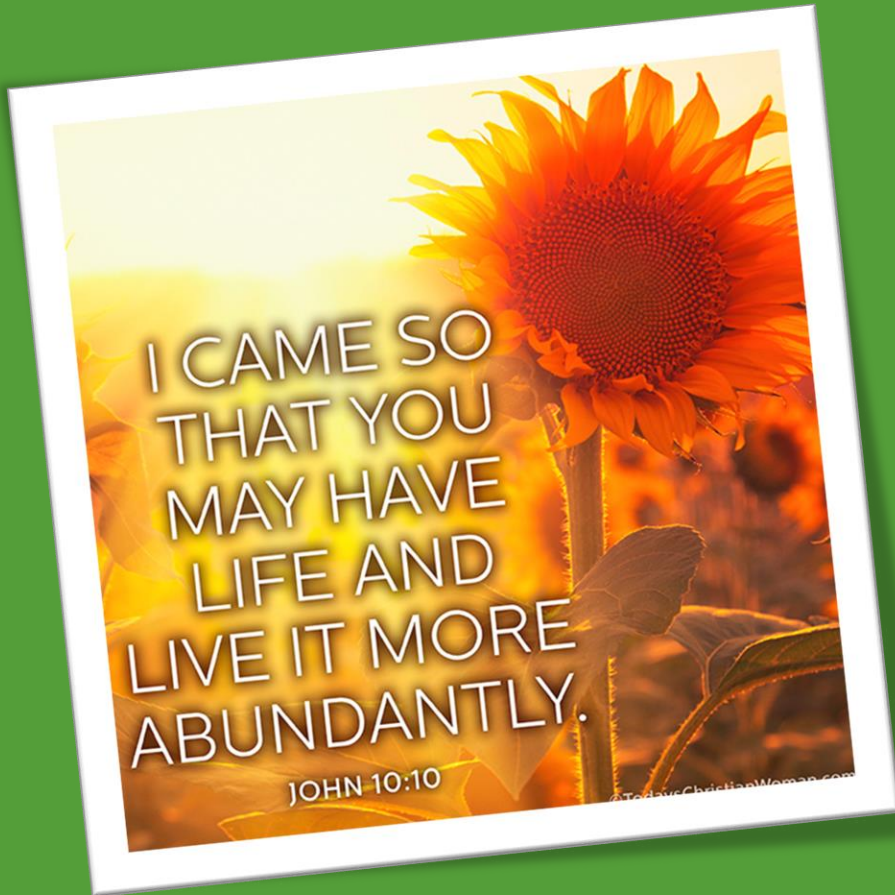

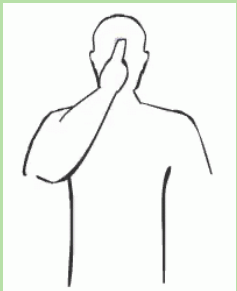
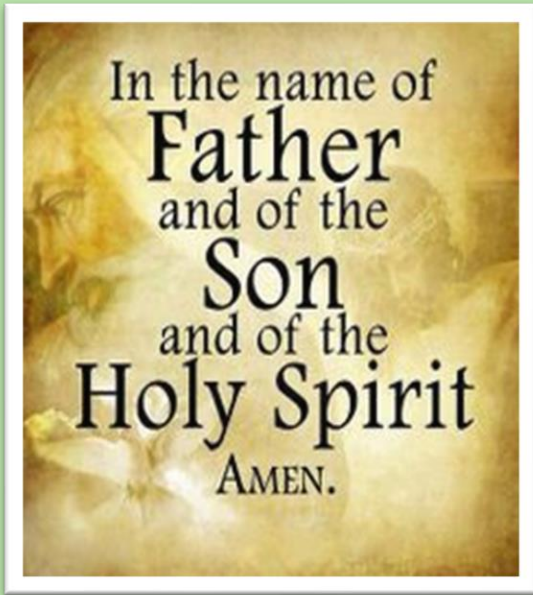

That You will teach me to trust You

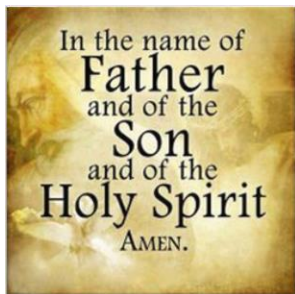

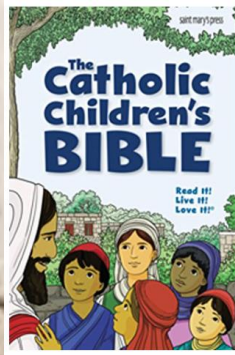

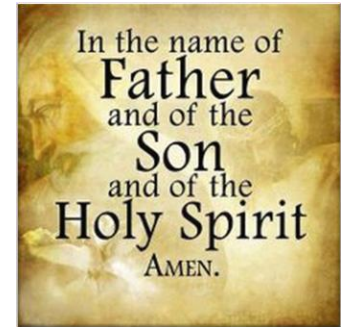

He says: “Your prayer gives me strength and helps me to discern and to accompany the Church, listening to the Holy Spirit.”

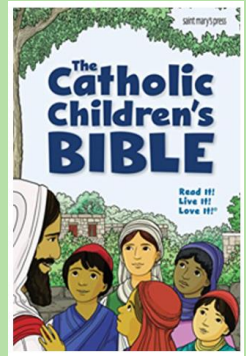
We pray that everyone who is part of the Church will pray for Pope Francis that he will carry out his mission to serve the Church.

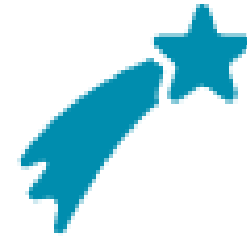
