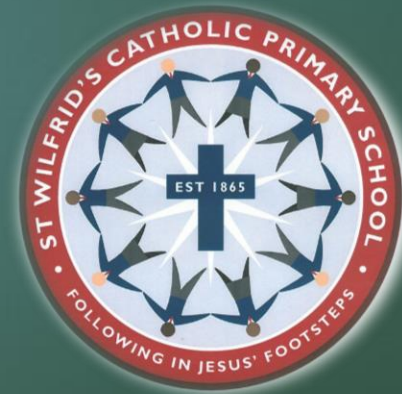
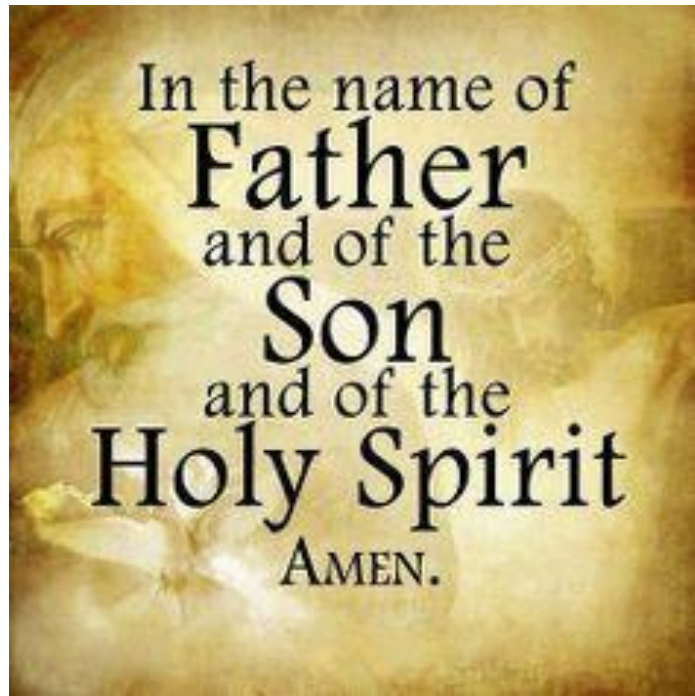

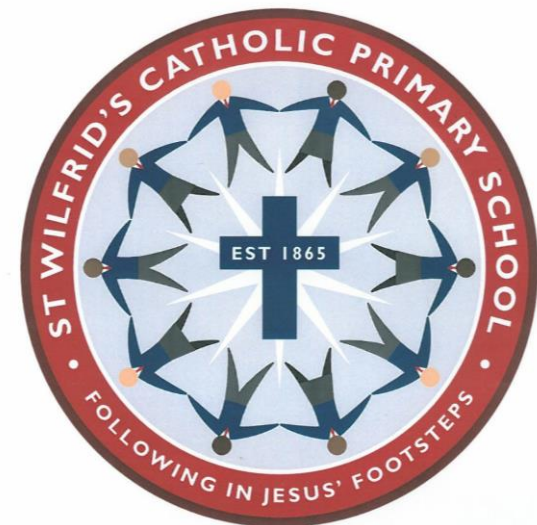

I give back happily.

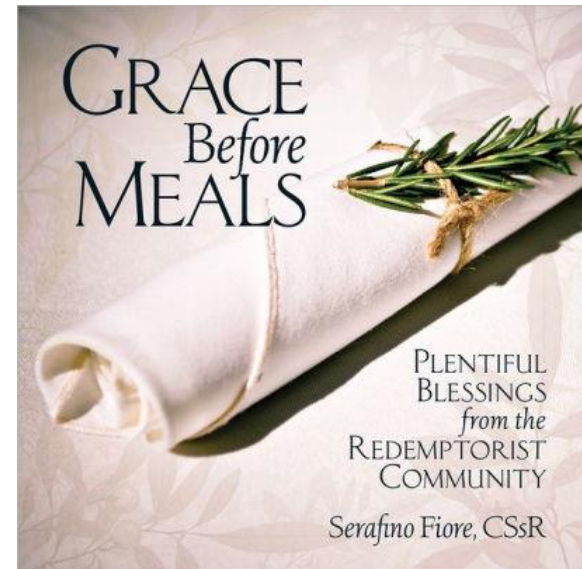
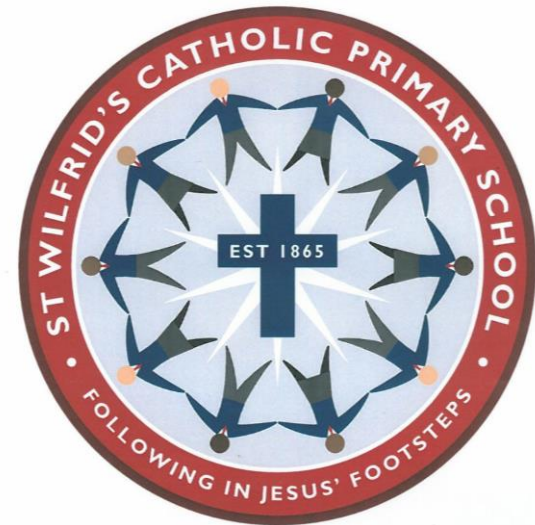
Take all my laughter, all my tears,

# Prayer after Lunch

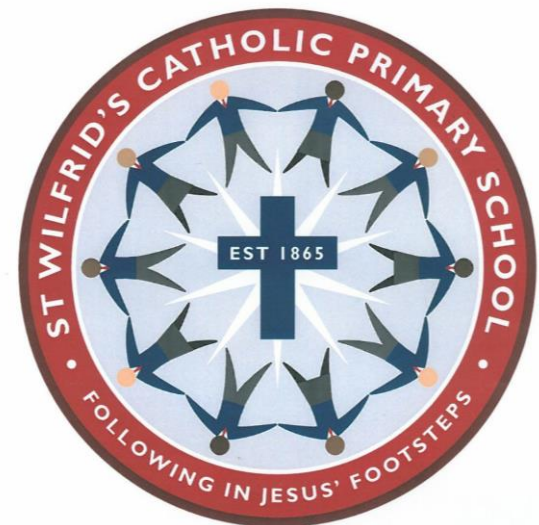
Thank you, God, for the food we have eaten.

Thank you for my family

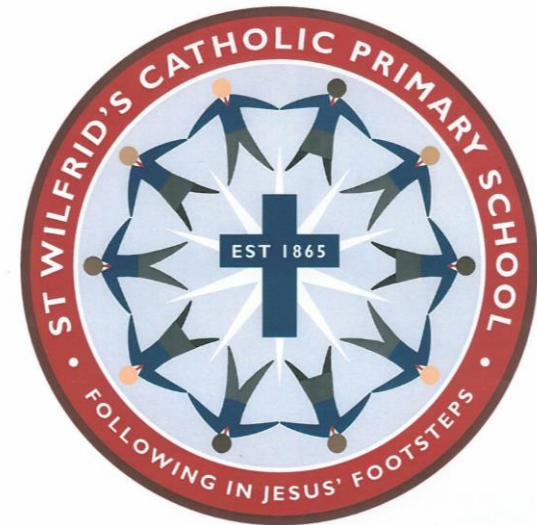
And all the friends you give to me.

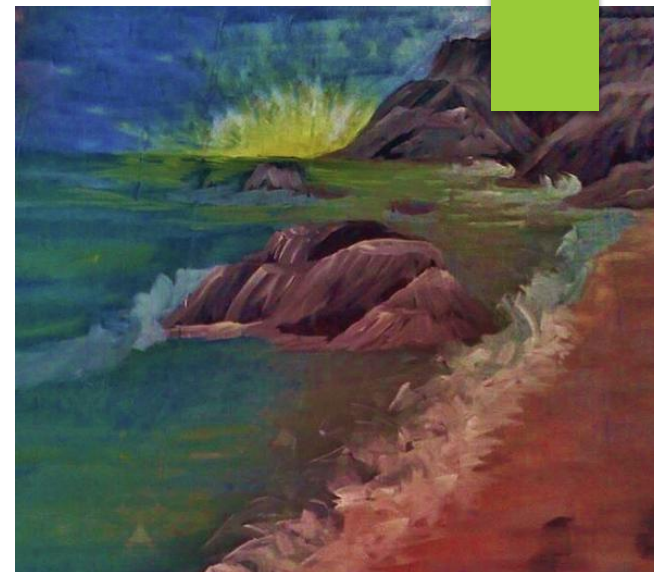

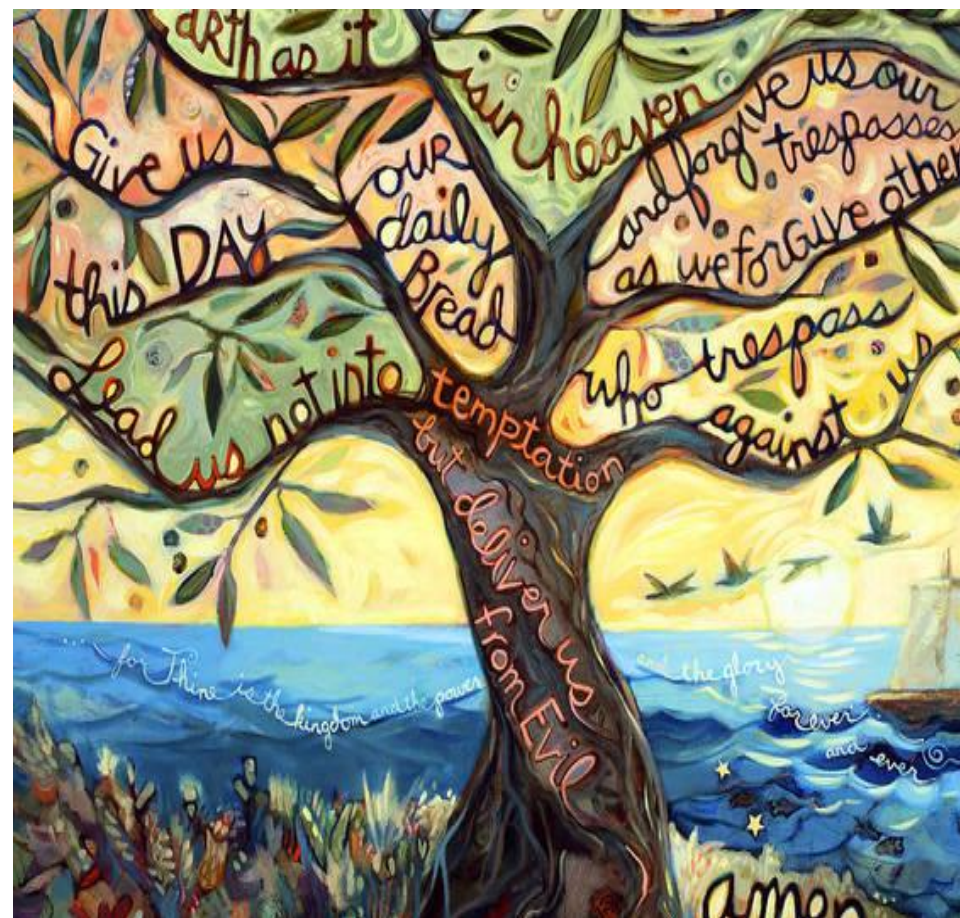


# St Wilfrid's School Prayer

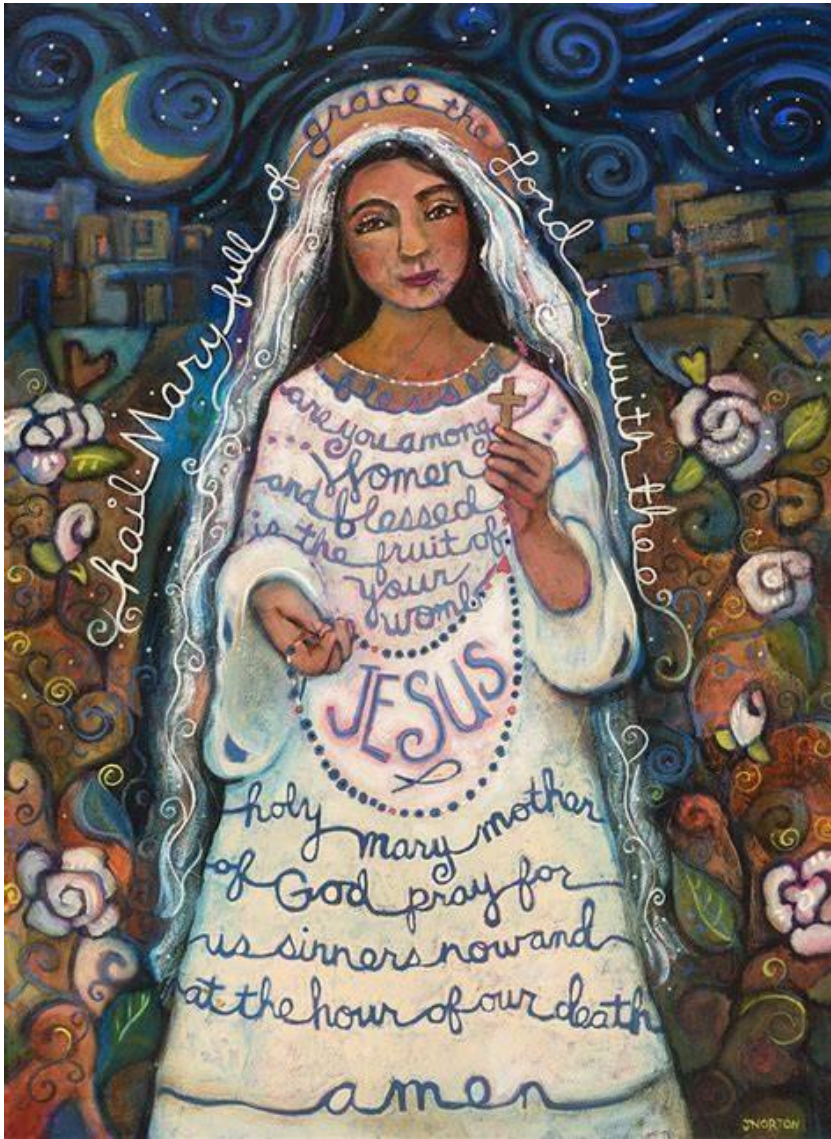




Our Father, Who art in
