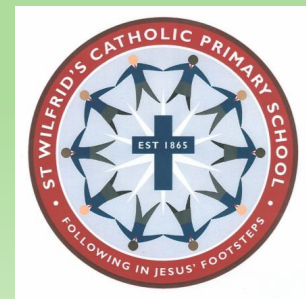
RED WEDNESDAY
