Announcement of the date of Easter and movable feasts

After the Gospel, following a long-established custom of the Church, the deacon or cantor may proclaim the movable feasts of the current year, in the following form:

Know, dear brethren that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Saviour, On the 5th March will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. On the 20th April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the 29th May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the 8th June, the feast of Pentecost. On the 22nd June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the 30th November, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.
