Desk top assessment completed to check if compliance of the following criteria.

- Aged 6-18 years. YAC (Young Adult Carers) 18-25
- Young person/family supported by a plan (TAF,CIN or CP) (Not applicable to YAC programme)
- If not, young person/family have been on one of the above in the past 12 months. Or been subject to a now closed single assessment.
- Live with a person who has mental or physical disability or who has learning disability or substance misuse issues.
- Young people living with someone who is terminally ill are given exception to the above.

Assessment arranged with family and if needed lead professional.

Rejection notification to referrer explaining why. Information about universal services given.
