On 16th of July 1969, three brave astronauts set off to the moon. These three men (who were called Buzz Aldrin, Neil Armstrong and Michael Collins) stepped onto the rocket. These three men were about to do something no-one has ever done before. The brave astronauts, who were about to become heroes, were being watched by 650 million people. As they were stepping onto the rocket, they saw the cameras behind them. On the rocket, the floor felt like it was coming up. The rocket, that was named Apollo 11, shot up into the air. They were flying up into space travelling 250,000 miles to the moon.

After years of testing and training, three men were about to make history by being the first humans to step foot on the moon's rocky surface. In July, 1969, Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins climbed on to the famous Rocket-Apollo 11. Apollo 11 set off with speeds up to 3,000 miles per hour. After 4 days 6 hours and 45 minutes, they ~~arrived~~ ^{arrived} 250,000 miles from earth on July 21st. (With 30 seconds of fuel left) Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin were looking for a safe space to land. While they were landing, Michael Collins ^{was} orbiting the moon and taking pictures.

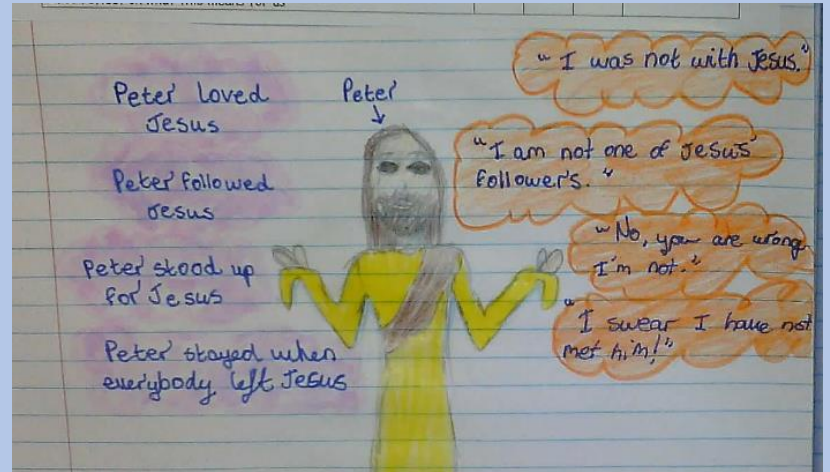

He came to Simon Peter, who said to him, "Lord, are you going to wash my feet?"

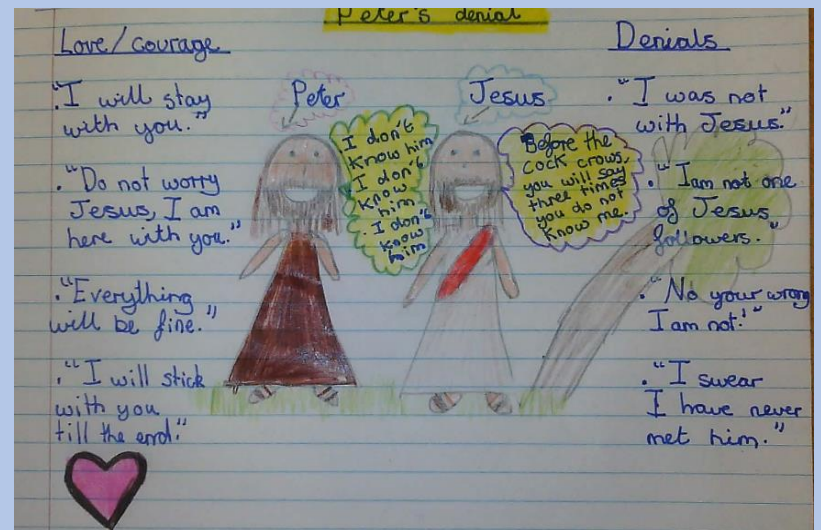
Jesus replied, "You do not realize now what I'm doing, but ~~both~~ later you will understand."
