And the feeling of water raining down upon you like a baptism.





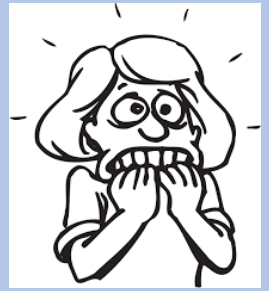

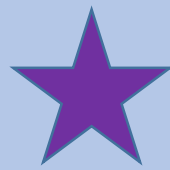
